- AN ACT to amend the state finance law, in relation to Tribal-state compact revenue accounts

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 99-h of the state finance law, as 2 amended by chapter 747 of the laws of 2006, is amended to read as 3 follows:

4 Moneys of the account, following appropriation by the legislature, 3. 5 shall be available for purposes including but not limited to: (a) 6 reimbursements or payments to municipal governments that host tribal 7 casinos pursuant to a tribal-state compact for costs incurred in 8 connection with services provided to such casinos or arising as a result 9 thereof, for economic development opportunities and job expansion programs authorized by the executive law; provided, 10 however, that for gaming facility located in the CITY OF BUFFALO, county of Erie, the 11 any [municipal governments hosting the facility] CITY OF 12 BUFFALO, shall [collectively] receive a minimum of [twenty-five] SEVENTY-FIVE percent 13 of the negotiated percentage of the net drop from electronic gaming 14 devices the state receives pursuant to the compact, and provided further 15 that for any gaming facility located in the city of Niagara Falls, coun-16 17 of Niagara a minimum of [twenty-five] SEVENTY-FIVE percent of the ty 18 negotiated percentage of the net drop from electronic gaming devices the state receives pursuant to the compact shall be distributed in accord-19 ance with subdivision four of this section, and provided further that 20 for any gaming facility located in the county or counties of Cattarau-21 22 Chautauqua or Allegany, the municipal governments of the state qus, 23 hosting the facility shall collectively receive a minimum of twenty-five 24 percent of the negotiated percentage of the net drop from electronic

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gaming devices the state receives pursuant to the compact; and provided 1 2 further that pursuant to chapter five hundred ninety of the laws of two 3 thousand four, a minimum of twenty-five percent of the revenues received 4 by the state pursuant to the state's compact with the St. Regis Mohawk tribe shall be made available to the counties of Franklin and St. Lawrence, and affected towns in such counties. Each such county and its 5 6 7 affected towns shall receive fifty percent of the moneys made available 8 the state; and (b) support and services of treatment programs for by 9 persons suffering from gambling addictions. Moneys not appropriated for 10 such purposes shall be transferred to the general fund for the support of government during the fiscal year in which they are received. 11

12 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that 13 the amendments to subdivision 3 of section 99-h of the state finance law 14 made by section one of this act shall not affect the expiration of such 15 section and shall be deemed to expire therewith.
