2 (F) RESIDENTIAL PLACEMENT SERVICES; AND

4 3. THE POST-ADOPTION SERVICES PROGRAM SHALL BE AVAILABLE TO ANY PERSON
5 WHO IS A RESIDENT OF NEW YORK STATE THAT HAS BEEN ADOPTED AND IS UNDER
6 EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE OR IS THE ADOPTIVE PARENT OF A PERSON UNDER THE
7 AGE OF EIGHTEEN.

8 S 2. The sum of six million dollars (\$6,000,000), or so much thereof
9 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated to the office of children
10 and family services from any moneys in the state treasury in the general
11 fund to the credit of the state purposes account not otherwise appropri-
12 ated, for its expenses in carrying out the provisions of this act. Such
13 sum shall be payable on the audit and warrant of the state comptroller
14 on vouchers certified or approved by the commissioner of the office of
15 children and family services, or his or her designated representative in
16 the manner provided by law.

17 S 3. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall
18 have become a law and shall apply to children who have been adopted and
19 parents who have adopted children before, on or after such date.
