AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to the issuance of a superintendent's certificate to persons possessing exceptional qualifications

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 3003 of the education law is amended by adding a new subdivision 3-a to read as follows:
- 3 THE COMMISSIONER, AT THE REQUEST OF A BOARD OF EDUCATION OR 3-A. A. BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES, SHALL PROVIDE FOR ANCE OF A SUPERINTENDENT'S CERTIFICATE TO ANY PERSON POSSESSING EXCEP-5
- TIONAL QUALIFICATIONS IN SPECIFIC BUSINESS OPERATIONS WHO DOES NOT 7 ALL OF THE GRADUATE COURSE OR TEACHING REQUIREMENTS OF SUBDIVISION ONE
- OF THIS SECTION. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBDIVISION "EXCEPTIONAL QUALI-8 FICATIONS" MEANS THE CANDIDATE HAS EARNED A POST GRADUATE DEGREE FROM AN 9
- 10 ACCREDITED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY AND HAS AT LEAST FIVE YEARS EXPERIENCE
- AS CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF A COMPANY OR ORGANIZATION. 11
- 12 EMPLOYEE WORK FORCE AND ANNUAL SALES OR OPERATING REVENUES OF SUCH
- COMPANY SHALL BE FACTORS CONSIDERED IN THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH A CERTIF-13 ICATE. 14
- 15 SUPERINTENDENT RECEIVING HIS CERTIFICATE AS SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH A OF THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL 16 COMPLETE
- 17 TWELVE SEMESTER HOURS OF GRADUATE STUDY IN THE FIELD OF SCHOOL ADMINIS-TRATION AND SUPERVISION WITHIN TWO YEARS OF RECEIPT OF HIS OR HER 18
- 19 CERTIFICATE.
- 20 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
