AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to eliminating fuel pass-along charges for occupants of rent controlled accommodations

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The administrative code of the city of New York is amended
2 by adding a new section 26-407.1 to read as follows:
3 S 26-407.1 FUEL PASS-ALONG TO TENANTS OF RENT CONTROLLED ACCOMMO-
4 DATIONS PROHIBITED. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, RULE,
5 REGULATION, CHARTER OR ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, NO TENANT OF ANY HOUSING
6 ACCOMMODATION WHICH IS SUBJECT TO RENT CONTROL SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A
7 FUEL ADJUSTMENT OR PASS-ALONG INCREASE IN RENT AND ANY SUCH INCREASE TO
8 SUCH TENANT SHALL BE NULL AND VOID.
9 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of September next
10 succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law; provided that
11 the addition of section 26-407.1 to the city rent and rehabilitation law
12 made by section one of this act shall remain in full force and effect
13 only as long as the public emergency requiring the regulation and
14 control of residential rents and evictions continues, as provided in
15 subdivision 3 of section 1 of the local emergency housing rent control
16 act.
