AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to the residence of members of the auto trades employed by a city with a population of one million or more

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of the public officers law is amended by adding a
2 new subdivision 2-e to read as follows:
3 2-E. NEITHER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, NOR OF ANY GENERAL,
4 SPECIAL OR LOCAL LAW, CHARTER, CODE, ORDINANCE, RESOLUTION, RULE OR
5 REGULATION, REQUIRING A PERSON TO BE A RESIDENT OF THE POLITICAL SUBDI-
6 VISION OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE BY WHICH HE OR SHE IS
7 EMPLOYED, SHALL APPLY TO A PERSON EMPLOYED BY A CITY WITH A POPULATION
8 OF ONE MILLION OR MORE WHO WORKS IN THE TITLE OF AUTO MECHANIC, AUTO
9 BODY WORKER, AUTO MACHINIST, ELECTRICIAN (AUTOMOBILE), OR A SIMILAR OR
10 SUBSTANTIALLY EQUIVALENT TITLE AND WHO RESIDES IN A COUNTY WITHIN THE
11 STATE CONTIGUOUS TO SUCH MUNICIPALITY.
12 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
