AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to the appointment of college and university students as election inspectors

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 3-400 of the election law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 6-a to read as follows:
 - 6-A. NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBDIVISION SIX OF THIS SECTION, ANY PERSON WHO IS A FULL-TIME COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY STUDENT MAY BE CERTIFIED AND ACT AS AN ELECTION INSPECTOR OR POLL CLERK IN THE COUNTY OR, WITHIN THE CITY OF NEW YORK, THE CITY IN WHICH SUCH PERSON'S COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY IS LOCATED IF HE OR SHE:
 - (A) IS REGISTERED TO VOTE IN THIS STATE;
 - (B) HOLDS NO ELECTIVE OFFICE;

- 10 (C) IS NOT A CANDIDATE FOR ANY PUBLIC OFFICE TO BE VOTED FOR BY THE 11 VOTERS OF THE DISTRICT IN WHICH HE OR SHE IS TO SERVE, AND IS NOT THE 12 SPOUSE, PARENT OR CHILD OF SUCH A CANDIDATE; AND
- 13 (D) IS ABLE TO SPEAK AND READ THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE AND WRITE IT LEGI-14 BLY.
- 15 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
