AN ACT to amend the domestic relations law, in relation to adoption records

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 114 of the domestic relations law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 5 to read as follows:
- 5. AN ADOPTIVE PERSON WHO HAS REACHED HIS OR HER MAJORITY MAY HAVE ACCESS TO HIS OR HER ORIGINAL BIRTH CERTIFICATE WITHOUT THE NECESSITY OF A COURT ORDER UPON PROOF TO THE COURT IN WHICH ORDER THEWAS GRANTED ADOPTIVE PERSON AND HIS OR HER BIRTH PARENTS HAVE REGISTERED 7 WITH THE STATE'S ADOPTION REGISTRY AND HAVE CONSENTED TO THE RELEASE 8 IDENTIFYING INFORMATION. ΙF ONLY ONE BIRTH PARENT EXECUTED THE 9 SURRENDER AGREEMENT OR CONSENTED TO THE ADOPTION, THEN THE REGISTRATION IN SAID REGISTRY IS NOT NECESSARY FOR THE 10 THE OTHER BIRTH PARENT
- 11 RELEASE OF THE INFORMATION PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION.
  12 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
