AN ACT to amend the general obligations law, in relation to compensation for injury caused by the illegal sale of intoxicating liquor

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 11-101 of the general obligations law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 5 to read as follows:
- 5. ANY PERSON WHO IS INJURED AS SET FORTH IN SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION SHALL HAVE A RIGHT OF ACTION AGAINST ANY PERSON WHO SELLS TO A PERSON OR PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF TWENTY-ONE YEARS FALSE IDENTIFICATION WHICH IS USED TO OBTAIN OR PROCURE LIQUOR OR ANY OTHER ALCOHOLIC BEVER-7 AGE.
- 8 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
