AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to increasing penalties
for violations of the elective franchise

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 17-166 of the election law is amended to read as
2 follows:
3 S 17-166. Penalty. Any person convicted of a misdemeanor under this
4 article shall BE CONVICTED OF A CLASS A MISDEMEANOR for a first offense
5 [be punished] PUNISHABLE by A SENTENCE OF imprisonment for [not more
6 than] UP TO one year, or by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars
7 nor more than five hundred dollars, or by both such fine and imprison-
8 ment. Any person who, having been convicted of a misdemeanor under this
9 article, shall thereafter be convicted of another misdemeanor under this
10 article, shall be guilty of a CLASS D felony, AND FOR ANY SUBSEQUENT
11 MISDEMEANOR OFFENSE UNDER THIS ARTICLE, A CLASS B FELONY.
12 ANY PERSON CONVICTED OF A FELONY UNDER THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE CONVICTED
13 OF A CLASS D FELONY FOR A FIRST OFFENSE AND FOR ANY SUBSEQUENT FELONY
14 OFFENSE UNDER THIS ARTICLE, A CLASS B FELONY.
15 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-
16 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
