AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to establishing a dietary supplements safety committee

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The public health law is amended by adding a new section 22 to read as follows:

3 S 22. DIETARY SUPPLEMENTS SAFETY COMMITTEE. 1. THERE IS HEREBY ESTAB-4 LISHED IN THE DEPARTMENT THE DIETARY SUPPLEMENTS SAFETY COMMITTEE TO BE 5 COMPOSED OF EIGHTEEN MEMBERS WHO SHALL BE APPOINTED IN THE FOLLOWING 6 MANNER: THREE SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE TEMPORARY PRESIDENT OF THE 7 TWO SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE SENATE; SENATE; 8 THREE SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE ASSEMBLY; TWO SHALL BE 9 APPOINTED BY THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE ASSEMBLY; AND EIGHT SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR. THE GOVERNOR SHALL DESIGNATE THE CHAIRPERSON 10 THE COMMITTEE. THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE SHALL BE REPRESENTATIVE 11 OF 12 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH FIELD, HEALTH CARE SERVICES PROVIDERS, DIETICIANS SUCH APPOINTING OFFICIALS SHALL EITHER REPLACE OR 13 AND NUTRITIONISTS. 14 REAPPOINT THE MEMBERS OF SUCH COMMITTEE FOR THREE YEAR TERMS, ACCORDING 15 TO THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE:

16 (A) EFFECTIVE JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND ELEVEN: ANY THREE ORIGINAL 17 APPOINTEES OF THE GOVERNOR, ONE ORIGINAL APPOINTEE OF THE TEMPORARY 18 PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE, ONE ORIGINAL APPOINTEE OF THE SPEAKER OF THE 19 ASSEMBLY AND ONE ORIGINAL APPOINTEE OF THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE 20 SENATE;

(B) EFFECTIVE JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND TWELVE: ANY THREE OF THE
REMAINING ORIGINAL APPOINTEES OF THE GOVERNOR, ONE OF THE REMAINING
ORIGINAL APPOINTEES OF THE TEMPORARY PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE, ONE OF THE
REMAINING ORIGINAL APPOINTEES OF THE SPEAKER OF THE ASSEMBLY AND ONE
ORIGINAL APPOINTEE OF THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE ASSEMBLY;

(C) EFFECTIVE JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND THIRTEEN: THE TWO REMAINING 1 ORIGINAL APPOINTEES OF THE GOVERNOR, THE REMAINING ORIGINAL APPOINTEE OF 2 3 THE TEMPORARY PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE, THE REMAINING ORIGINAL APPOINTEE 4 OF THE SPEAKER OF THE ASSEMBLY, THE REMAINING ORIGINAL APPOINTEE OF THE 5 MINORITY LEADER OF THE SENATE AND THE REMAINING ORIGINAL APPOINTEE OF 6 THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE ASSEMBLY; 7 (D) REPLACEMENTS OR REAPPOINTMENTS THEREAFTER SHALL BE MADE AT THE 8 EXPIRATION OF THE TERM OF EACH MEMBER, BY THE APPOINTING OFFICIAL WHO ORIGINALLY APPOINTED SUCH MEMBER; AND 9 10 (E) VACANCIES SHALL BE FILLED BY APPOINTMENT IN LIKE MANNER FOR UNEX-PIRED TERMS. 11 12 2. THE COMMITTEE SHALL EVALUATE THE SAFETY AND EFFICACY OF DIETARY SUPPLEMENTS AND ITS DUTIES SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, 13 THE 14 FOLLOWING: 15 (A) ESTABLISH A SYSTEM OF REPORTING ADVERSE EVENTS ASSOCIATED WITH DIETARY SUPPLEMENTS AND SUPPORT VOLUNTARY REPORTING BY CONSUMERS, HEALTH 16 17 PRACTITIONERS AND OTHERS; (B) ASSESS AVAILABLE DATA AND MAKE SPECIFIC RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE 18 19 COMMISSIONER REGARDING BANNING THE SALE OF CERTAIN DIETARY SUPPLEMENTS THE COMMITTEE DEEMS HARMFUL; AND 20 21 (C) ESTABLISH A PUBLIC HEALTH EDUCATION CAMPAIGN ON DIETARY SUPPLE-22 MENTS, WITH VARIATIONS SPECIFICALLY DIRECTED TO TARGET DIFFERENT GROUPS. 3. THE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL MEET AT LEAST THREE TIMES A YEAR, AT THE 23 24 REQUEST OF THE CHAIRPERSON. 25 4. THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL SHALL RECEIVE NO COMPENSATION FOR THEIR 26 SERVICES, BUT SHALL BE ALLOWED THEIR ACTUAL AND NECESSARY EXPENSES 27 INCURRED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THEIR DUTIES. 28 THE COMMISSIONER IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO BAN THE SALE OF ANY 5. 29 DIETARY SUPPLEMENT SOLD OR OFFERED FOR SALE IN THIS STATE UPON RECOMMEN-DATION BY THE COMMITTEE. ANY SUCH BAN MAY BE LIMITED IN ITS SCOPE TO BAN 30 THE SALE OF ANY SUCH SUPPLEMENT TO MINORS ONLY. 31 32 6. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE TERM "DIETARY SUPPLEMENT" MEANS PRODUCT (OTHER THAN TOBACCO) THAT IS INTENDED TO SUPPLEMENT THE 33 (A) A 34 DIET AND THAT BEARS OR CONTAINS ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING DIETARY INGREDIENTS: A VITAMIN, A MINERAL, AN HERB OR OTHER BOTANICAL, AN AMINO 35 ACID, A DIETARY SUBSTANCE FOR THE USE BY A PERSON TO SUPPLEMENT THE DIET 36 37 BY INCREASING THE TOTAL DAILY INTAKE, OR A CONCENTRATE, METABOLITE, CONSTITUENT, EXTRACT, OR COMBINATIONS OF THESE INGREDIENTS; (B) INTENDED FOR INGESTION IN PILL, CAPSULE, TABLET, OR LIQUID FORM; AND (C) LABELED 38 39 40 AS A "DIETARY SUPPLEMENT" PURSUANT TO THE FEDERAL DIETARY SUPPLEMENT HEALTH AND EDUCATION ACT, 21 U.S.C. 321, AS AMENDED. 41 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2010. The appointments 42 S required to be made pursuant to subdivision 1 of section 22 of the 43 44 public health law, as added by section one of this act, shall be made on 45 or before such effective date.
