AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to creating the crimes of solicitation or recruitment of persons in criminal street gang activity

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding two new sections 100.23
2 and 100.25 to read as follows:

3 S 100.23 SOLICITATION OR RECRUITMENT OF PERSONS IN CRIMINAL STREET GANG
4 ACTIVITY.

5 A PERSON IS GUILTY OF SOLICITATION OR RECRUITMENT OF PERSONS IN CRIMI-
6 NAL STREET GANG ACTIVITY WHEN HE OR SHE RECRUITS, EMPLOYS, SOLICITS,
7 INDUCES, COMMANDS OR OTHERWISE ATTEMPTS TO CAUSE SUCH OTHER PERSON TO BE
8 OR REMAIN AS A MEMBER OF A CRIMINAL STREET GANG OR CONSPIRE TO DO SO,
9 WITH THE INTENT THAT THE PERSON BEING RECRUITED, SOLICITED, INDUCED,
10 COMMANDED OR CAUSED TO BE OR REMAIN A MEMBER OF SUCH GANG PARTICIPATE IN
11 CONDUCT CONSTITUTING A CRIME.

12 FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "CRIMINAL STREET GANG" MEANS A FORMAL OR
13 INFORMAL GROUP, CLUB, ORGANIZATION, OR ASSOCIATION OF THREE OR MORE
14 INDIVIDUALS, WHO ACT IN CONCERT, OR AGREE TO ACT IN CONCERT, WITH A
15 PURPOSE THAT ANY OF THESE PERSONS ALONE, OR IN ANY COMBINATION, COMMIT
16 OR WILL COMMIT, TWO OR MORE CRIMES UNDER THIS CHAPTER.

17 SOLICITATION OR RECRUITMENT OF PERSONS IN CRIMINAL STREET GANG ACTIV-
18 ITY IS A CLASS E FELONY.

19 S 100.25 SOLICITATION OR RECRUITMENT OF MINORS IN CRIMINAL STREET GANG
20 ACTIVITY.

21 A PERSON IS GUILTY OF SOLICITATION OR RECRUITMENT OF MINORS IN CRIMI-
22 NAL STREET GANG ACTIVITY WHEN HE OR SHE RECRUITS, EMPLOYS, SOLICITS,
23 INDUCES, COMMANDS OR OTHERWISE ATTEMPTS TO CAUSE ANOTHER PERSON UNDER
24 EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE, TO BE OR REMAIN AS A MEMBER OF A CRIMINAL STREET

1 GANG OR CONSPIRE TO DO SO, WITH THE INTENT THAT THE PERSON UNDER EIGH-
2 TEEN YEARS OF AGE BEING RECRUITED, SOLICITED, INDUCED, COMMANDED OR
3 CAUSED TO BE OR REMAIN A MEMBER OF SUCH GANG PARTICIPATE IN CONDUCT
4 CONSTITUTING A CRIME.

5 FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "CRIMINAL STREET GANG" MEANS A FORMAL OR
6 INFORMAL GROUP, CLUB, ORGANIZATION, OR ASSOCIATION OF THREE OR MORE
7 INDIVIDUALS, WHO ACT IN CONCERT, OR AGREE TO ACT IN CONCERT, WITH A
8 PURPOSE THAT ANY OF THESE PERSONS ALONE, OR IN ANY COMBINATION, COMMIT
9 OR WILL COMMIT, TWO OR MORE CRIMES UNDER THIS CHAPTER.

10 SOLICITATION OR RECRUITMENT OF MINORS IN CRIMINAL STREET GANG ACTIVITY
11 IS A CLASS D FELONY.

12 S 2. Local laws; preemption. Nothing in this act shall prevent a local
13 governing body from adopting and enforcing laws consistent with this act
14 relating to criminal street gang activity and criminal street gang
15 violence. Where local laws duplicate or supplement this act, this act
16 shall be construed as providing alternative remedies and not as preempt-
17 ing such local laws.

18 S 3. Severability. If any provision of this act, or the application
19 thereof to any person or circumstance, shall be adjudged by any court of
20 competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such judgment
21 shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall
22 be confined in its operation to the provision of this act, or in its
23 application to the person or circumstance, directly involved in the
24 controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

25 S 4. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-
26 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
