AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to permit application requirements for regulated medical waste treatment, storage or disposal facilities

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 5 of section 27-1513 of the environmental
2 conservation law, as amended by chapter 180 of the laws of 1989, is
3 amended to read as follows:
4 5. As a condition of approval for such permit, any person who operates
5 a facility for the treatment, storage and disposal of regulated medical
6 waste shall provide:
7 (A) proof of liability insurance or other form of financial security
8 deemed sufficient by the commissioner to meet all responsibilities in
9 case of release of such waste causing damage; AND
10 (B) CERTIFICATION THAT SUCH ACTIVITIES CONFORM WITH EXISTING LOCAL
11 ZONING LAWS OR ORDINANCES.
12 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
