AN ACT to amend the penal law and the insurance law, in relation to motor vehicle insurance fraud

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 176.05 of the penal law, as  
2 amended by chapter 635 of the laws of 1996 and designated by chapter 2  
3 of the laws of 1998, is amended to read as follows:

4 1. A fraudulent insurance act is committed by any person who, knowing-  
5 ly and with intent to defraud presents, causes to be presented, or  
6 prepares with knowledge or belief that it will be presented to or by an  
7 insurer, self insurer, or purported insurer, or purported self insurer,  
8 or any agent thereof, any written statement as part of, or in support  
9 of, an application for the issuance of, or the rating of a POLICY INSUR-  
10 ING AGAINST LOSSES OR LIABILITIES ARISING OUT OF THE OWNERSHIP, OPERA-  
11 TION, OR USE OF A MOTOR VEHICLE, A commercial insurance policy, or  
12 certificate or evidence of self insurance for commercial insurance or  
13 commercial self insurance, or a claim for payment or other benefit  
14 pursuant to an insurance policy or self insurance program for commercial  
15 or personal insurance which he OR SHE knows to: (i) contain materially  
16 false information concerning any fact material thereto; or (ii) conceal,  
17 for the purpose of misleading, information concerning any fact material  
18 thereto.

19 S 2. Paragraph 11 of subsection (d) of section 405 of the insurance  
20 law, as added by chapter 678 of the laws of 1997, is amended to read as  
21 follows:

22 (11) an assessment of law enforcement and insurance company activities  
23 to detect and curtail the incidence of operating a motor vehicle without  
24 proper insurance coverage as required by this chapter AND THE INCIDENCE
