Introduced by Sens. C. JOHNSON, HASSELL-THOMPSON, OPPENHEIMER, PARKER, STACHOWSKI, VALESKY -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Housing, Construction and Community Development -- reported favorably from said committee and committed to the Committee on Finance -- committee discharged, bill amended, ordered reprinted as amended and recommitted to said committee

AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to exempting sleeping quarters in children's overnight camps from conflicting provisions of the state uniform fire prevention and building codes

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 378 of the executive law, as added
2 by chapter 707 of the laws of 1981, is amended to read as follows:
3 1. Standards for the construction of all buildings or classes of
4 buildings, or the installation of equipment therein, including standards
5 for materials to be used in connection therewith, and standards for
6 safety and sanitary conditions. NOTWITHSTANDING THE ABOVE, SLEEPING
7 QUARTERS IN A CHILDREN'S OVERNIGHT CAMP AS DEFINED IN SUBDIVISION ONE OF
8 SECTION THIRTEEN HUNDRED NINETY-TWO OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH LAW SHALL BE
9 GOVERNED BY SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION THIRTEEN HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR OF
10 SUCH LAW.
11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
