AN ACT to amend the navigation law, in relation to the wearing of personal flotation devices when underway on a pleasure vessel less than twenty-one feet

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The subdivision heading of subdivision 1 of section 40 of
2 the navigation law, as amended by chapter 74 of the laws of 1998, is
3 amended to read as follows:
4 [personal] PERSONAL flotation devices.
5 S 2. Subdivision 1 of section 40 of the navigation law is amended by
6 adding a new paragraph (e) to read as follows:
7 (E) NO OWNER OR OPERATOR OF A PLEASURE VESSEL LESS THAN TWENTY-ONE
8 FEET, INCLUDING ROWBOATS, CANOES, AND KAYAKS SHALL PERMIT ITS OPERATION,
9 BETWEEN NOVEMBER FIRST AND MAY FIRST, UNLESS EACH PERSON ON BOARD SUCH
10 VESSEL IS WEARING A SECURELY FASTENED UNITED STATES COAST GUARD APPROVED
11 WEARABLE PERSONAL FLOTATION DEVICE OF AN APPROPRIATE SIZE WHEN SUCH
12 VESSEL IS UNDERWAY.
13 S 3. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-
14 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
