amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to providing a multiple event caterer's permit

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 98 of the alcoholic beverage control law is amended by adding a new subdivision 1-a to read as follows:

THE LIQUOR AUTHORITY IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO CATERERS A PERMIT EFFECTIVE FOR A ONE YEAR PERIOD WHICH SHALL AUTHORIZE THE SERVICE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT MULTIPLE FUNCTIONS, OCCASIONS OR EVENTS RESTAURANT, CLUB, BALLROOM, OR OTHER PREMISES. CATERERS WHO HAVE BEEN ISSUED SUCH A PERMIT SHALL BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE THEAUTHORITY WITH INFORMATION, AS SPECIFIED BY THELIOUOR AUTHORITY, REGARDING EACH FUNCTION OR EVENT AND ITS LOCATION AT LEAST FIVE BUSINESS DAYS PRIOR TO THE FUNCTION OR EVENT. THE PERMIT SHALL AUTHORIZE SERVICE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE HOURS, FIXED BY OR PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION FIVE OF SECTION ONE HUNDRED SIX OF THIS CHAPTER, DURING WHICH ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES MAY LAWFULLY BE SOLD OR SERVED UPON PREMISES TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT RETAIL FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMP-14 TION IN THE COMMUNITY IN WHICH IS LOCATED THE PREMISES ΙN WHICH 16 FUNCTION OR EVENT IS HELD. A PERMIT SHALL ONLY BE ISSUED TO AN ON-PREM-FEE ISES LIQUOR, WINE OR BEER LICENSEE. THE THEREFORE SHALL BETWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS. SUCH A PERMIT AND THE EXERCISE OF THE PRIVILEGE GRANTED THEREBY MAY BE SUBJECTED TO SUCH RULES BY THE 19 LIOUOR AUTHORITY

20 AS IT DEEMS NECESSARY. S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 21 22 it shall have become a law.
