AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to allowing the use of rifles for hunting big game in a certain portion of the county of Chautauqua; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Item (i) of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907
2 of the environmental conservation law, as amended by chapter 441 of the

48 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately, provided that the amend-
49 ments to item (i) of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907 of
50 the environmental conservation law made by section one of this act shall
51 be subject to the expiration and reversion of such paragraph pursuant to
52 section 13 of chapter 600 of the laws of 1993, as amended, when upon
53 such date the provisions of section two of this act shall take effect
54 and provided further that the provisions of this act shall expire and be
55 deemed repealed one year after such effective date.
