AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to training  
requirements regarding sex offenses for security guards

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-  
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 89-n of the general business law  
2 is amended by adding a new paragraph b-1 to read as follows:

3 B-1. A TWELVE HOUR SEX OFFENSE TRAINING COURSE, A COMPONENT OF WHICH  
4 SHALL CONCENTRATE ON AN APPROPRIATE RESPONSE TO VICTIMS OF SUCH  
5 OFFENSES;

6 S 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall  
7 have become a law.
