AN ACT to amend the Indian law and the public health law, in relation to prohibiting smoking in any Indian casino which has a current or pending gaming compact with the state

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The Indian law is amended by adding a new section 16 to
2 read as follows:
3 S 16. PROHIBIT SMOKING; CERTAIN CASINOS WITH GAMING COMPACTS. ANY
4 INDIAN NATION WITH A CURRENT OR PENDING GAMING COMPACT WITH THE STATE
5 SHALL ABIDE BY SECTION THIRTEEN HUNDRED NINETY-NINE-0 OF THE PUBLIC
6 HEALTH LAW.
7 S 2. Subdivisions 17 and 18 of section 1399-o of the public health
8 law, as amended by chapter 13 of the laws of 2003, are amended to read
9 as follows:
10 17. zoos; [and]
11 18. bingo facilities; AND ANY INDIAN NATION WITH A CURRENT OR PENDING
12 GAMING COMPACT WITH THE STATE THAT OPERATES A CASINO.
13 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
