AN ACT relating to authorizing the canal corporation to abandon canal
terminal lands in the Syracuse inner harbor

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. In accordance with section 50 of the canal law, it is here-
2 by found and determined that the present barge canal terminal located in
3 the city of Syracuse, Onondaga county, and all of its barge canal termi-
4 nal lands, consisting of approximately 3.85 acres located on the north-
5 ern, eastern and southern shore of the Syracuse inner harbor, including
6 two piers within the vicinity of Kirkpatrick Street and Solar Street,
7 are no longer necessary or useful as part of the barge canal system, as
8 an aid to navigation thereon, or for barge canal terminal purposes. The
9 New York state canal corporation is authorized to sell, convey or other-
10 wise dispose of any part of or all the right, title and interest to such
11 property, upon the approval of the director of the budget. Notwith-
12 standing the foregoing, any sale, conveyance or disposal of the barge
13 canal terminal or terminal lands shall be structured in a manner that
14 maintains public access to existing local waterfront revitalization
15 facilities, including the amphitheater and north pier, constructed with
16 state funds under title 11 of article 54 of the environmental conserva-
17 tion law (Environmental Protection Act).
18 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
