AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to powers granted to municipalities concerning public utility services

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 1020-h of the public authorities law, as added by
2 chapter 517 of the laws of 1986, is amended by adding two new subdivisions 12 and 13 to read as follows:
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4 12. NOTHING IN THIS TITLE SHALL BE CONSTRUED AS PREEMPTING, OR OTHERWISE LIMITING, THE RIGHTS OF ANY MUNICIPALITY LOCATED IN WHOLE OR IN
5 PART IN THE SERVICE AREA FROM EXERCISING ANY POWER OR AUTHORITY GRANTED
6 TO IT BY ARTICLE FOURTEEN-A OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW, INCLUDING THE
7 RIGHT TO ACQUIRE FACILITIES THROUGH EMINENT DOMAIN AS SET FORTH IN
8 SUBDIVISION SIX OF SECTION THREE HUNDRED SIXTY OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL
9 LAW.

11 13. IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE EXERCISE OF THE POWER OF EMINENT DOMAIN
12 SPECIFICALLY RESERVED TO MUNICIPALITIES LOCATED IN WHOLE OR IN PART IN
13 THE SERVICE AREA, THE LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS WITH RESPECT TO THE APPROPRIATE VALUATION OF LILCO'S PROPERTY, AS SET FORTH IN PARAGRAPHS (F)
14 THROUGH (M) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION, SHALL BE CONSIDERED BY
15 THE COURT IN ESTABLISHING JUST COMPENSATION FOR ANY PROPERTY TAKEN BY
16 ANY SUCH MUNICIPALITY.

18 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
