AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to affixing  
the price on fresh fruits and vegetables

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-  
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The agriculture and markets law is amended by adding a new  
2 section 214-i to read as follows:  
3 S 214-I. FRESH FRUITS AND VEGETABLES; AFFIXING PRICE. NO PERSON, FIRM,  
4 CORPORATION, PARTNERSHIP, ASSOCIATION OR OTHER BUSINESS ASSOCIATION  
5 SELLING AT RETAIL OR DISPLAYING FOR SALE AT RETAIL ANY FRESH FRUIT OR  
6 VEGETABLE SHALL STAMP OR IMPRINT DIRECTLY ON THE EDIBLE SKIN, RIND OR  
7 PEEL OF SUCH FRUIT OR VEGETABLE ANY MARK, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO  
8 THE PRICE OF SUCH PRODUCE.  
9 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall  
10 have become a law.
