AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to statements of specialty by a physician

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 6527 of the education law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 8 to read as follows:
- 8. A LICENSED PHYSICIAN MAY INCLUDE A STATEMENT THAT HE OR SHE HIS OR HER PRACTICE TO SPECIFIC FIELDS, BUT MAY ONLY INCLUDE A STATEMENT 5 OR SHE IS CERTIFIED OR ELIGIBLE FOR CERTIFICATION BY A PRIVATE OR PUBLIC BOARD OR PARENT ASSOCIATION IF THAT BOARD OR ASSOCIATION IS AN 7 AMERICAN BOARD OF MEDICAL SPECIALTIES MEMBER BOARD OR A MEMBER BOARD OF 8 THE AMERICAN OSTEOPATHIC ASSOCIATION, A BOARD OR ASSOCIATION WITH EQUIV-9 ALENT REOUIREMENTS APPROVED BY THAT PHYSICIAN AND SURGEON'S LICENSING BOARD, OR A BOARD OR ASSOCIATION WITH AN ACCREDITATION COUNCIL FOR GRAD-10 UATE MEDICAL EDUCATION APPROVED POSTGRADUATE TRAINING PROGRAM 11 PROVIDES COMPLETE TRAINING IN THAT SPECIALTY OR SUBSPECIALTY. 12
- 13 S 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 14 have become a law.
