AN ACT to amend the education law and the public health law, in relation to domestic violence course work or training

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 6505-d to read as follows:

3 6505-D. DOMESTIC VIOLENCE COURSE WORK OR TRAINING. EVERY REGISTERED NURSE AND LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE PRACTICING IN THIS STATE SHALL, ON OR 5 BEFORE JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND ELEVEN AND EVERY FOUR YEARS THEREAFT-PROFESSIONAL'S ER, COMPLETE COURSE WORK OR TRAINING APPROPRIATE TO THE7 PRACTICE APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT REGARDING DIAGNOSIS, TREATMENT, AND 8 DOCUMENTATION OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH REGULATORY STAND-9 ARDS PROMULGATED BY THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE HEALTH AND THE OFFICE FOR THE PREVENTION OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE. EACH 10 SUCH PROFESSIONAL SHALL DOCUMENT TO THE DEPARTMENT AT THE TIME OF REGIS-11 TRATION COMMENCING WITH THE FIRST REGISTRATION AFTER JANUARY FIRST, 12 13 THOUSAND ELEVEN THAT THE PROFESSIONAL HAS COMPLETED COURSE WORK OR TRAINING IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION. THE DEPARTMENT 14 SHALL PROVIDE 15 EXEMPTION FROM THIS REQUIREMENT TO ANYONE WHO REOUESTS SUCH AN EXEMPTION AND WHO (I) CLEARLY DEMONSTRATES TO THE DEPARTMENT'S SATISFAC-16 17 TION THAT THERE WOULD BE NO NEED FOR HIM OR HER TO COMPLETE SUCH COURSE WORK OR TRAINING BECAUSE OF THE NATURE OF HIS OR HER PRACTICE OR (II) 18 19 HAS COMPLETED COURSE WORK OR TRAINING DEEMED BY $_{
m THE}$ DEPARTMENT TO BE 20 WORK OR TRAINING APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT EOUIVALENT TO THECOURSE 21 PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONSULT WITH ORGANIZA-TIONS REPRESENTATIVE OF PROFESSIONS, INSTITUTIONS AND THOSE WITH EXPER-22 23 TISE IN DOMESTIC VIOLENCE WITH RESPECT TO THE REGULATORY **STANDARDS**

PROMULGATED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION.

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S 2. The title heading of title 2-E of article 2 of the public health law, as amended by chapter 477 of the laws of 2008, is amended to read as follows:

HIV/HBV/HCV PREVENTION TRAINING;

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE COURSE WORK OR TRAINING

- S 3. The public health law is amended by adding a new section 239-c to read as follows:
- 7 8 239-C. DOMESTIC VIOLENCE COURSE WORK OR TRAINING. EVERY PHYSICIAN, 9 PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT AND SPECIALIST ASSISTANT PRACTICING IN THE STATE 10 ON OR BEFORE JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND ELEVEN AND EVERY FOUR YEARS THEREAFTER, (A) COMPLETE COURSE WORK OR TRAINING, APPROPRIATE 11 PROFESSIONAL'S PRACTICE, APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT REGARDING DIAG-12 NOSIS, TREATMENT, AND DOCUMENTATION OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, IN ACCORDANCE 13 14 WITH REGULATORY STANDARDS PROMULGATED BY THE DEPARTMENT IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND THE OFFICE FOR THE PREVENTION 15 DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND (B) SO DOCUMENT TO THE DEPARTMENT. THE DEPARTMENT 16 SHALL PROVIDE AN EXEMPTION FROM THIS REQUIREMENT TO ANYONE WHO REQUESTS 17 EXEMPTION AND WHO (I) CLEARLY DEMONSTRATES TO THE DEPARTMENT'S 18 19 SATISFACTION THAT THERE WOULD BE NO NEED FOR HIM OR HER TO COMPLETE SUCH COURSE WORK OR TRAINING BECAUSE OF THE NATURE OF HIS OR HER PRACTICE OR 20 21 THAT HE OR SHE HAS COMPLETED COURSE WORK OR TRAINING DEEMED BY THE 22 DEPARTMENT TO BE EQUIVALENT TO THE COURSE WORK OR TRAINING THE DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONSULT 23 24 WITH ORGANIZATIONS REPRESENTATIVE OF PROFESSIONS, INSTITUTIONS AND THOSE 25 WITH EXPERTISE IN DOMESTIC VIOLENCE WITH RESPECT TO THE REGULATORY STAN-DARDS PROMULGATED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION. 26
- 27 S 4. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 28 it shall have become a law and provided further that the commissioners 29 of health and education may immediately take such steps as are necessary 30 for implementation of this act on such effective date.
