AN ACT to amend the real property tax law, in relation to alternative school tax and county tax apportionment in cities and towns

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 1316 of the real property tax law,
2 as added by chapter 556 of the laws of 2002, is amended to read as
3 follows:
4 3. [Within five days of] UPON APPLICATION BY THE CHIEF FISCAL OFFICER
5 OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT, MADE NO LATER THAN FIVE DAYS AFTER the establish-
6 ment of the latest final state equalization rate, the state board, WITH-
7 IN FIVE DAYS OF SUCH APPLICATION, shall notify both the appropriate
8 school district and the assessing unit of such designation. Such notice
9 shall contain instructions for the apportionment of the tax levy in
10 accordance with the provisions of subdivision seven of this section and
11 shall contain an apportionment rate computed in accordance with subdivi-
12 sion four of this section.
13 S 2. Subdivision 3 of section 847 of the real property tax law, as
14 added by chapter 556 of the laws of 2002, is amended to read as follows:
15 3. [Within five days of] UPON APPLICATION BY THE CHIEF FISCAL OFFICER
16 OF A COUNTY, MADE NO LATER THAN OCTOBER FIRST FOLLOWING the establish-
17 ment of the latest final state equalization rate, the state board, WITH-
18 IN FIVE DAYS OF SUCH APPLICATION, shall notify both the appropriate
19 county and the assessing unit of such designation. Such notice shall
20 contain instructions for the apportionment of the tax levy in accordance
21 with the provisions of subdivision seven of this section and shall
22 contain an apportionment rate computed in accordance with subdivision
23 four of this section.
24 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
