AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating the bridge crossing the Erie Canal on state route 291 as the Army Captain George A. Wood Memorial Bridge

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 342-ss 2 to read as follows:
  - S 342-SS. PORTION OF STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO BE DESIGNATED AS THE "ARMY CAPTAIN GEORGE A. WOOD MEMORIAL BRIDGE". THE BRIDGE ACROSS THE ERIE CANAL ON STATE HIGHWAY TWO HUNDRED NINETY-ONE IN THE TOWN OF MARCY, COUNTY OF ONEIDA SHALL BE DESIGNATED AND KNOWN AS THE "ARMY CAPTAIN GEORGE A. WOOD MEMORIAL BRIDGE" IN HONOR OF THE LATE ARMY CAPTAIN.
- 8 S 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the instal-9 lation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system 10 as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid 11 confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-12 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of 13 ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not be 14 changed as a result of this act.
- 15 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
