AN ACT to authorize the Long Island Youth Mentoring, Inc. to file an  
application for a real property tax exemption

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the asses-  
2     sor of the town of Islip is hereby authorized to accept from the Long  
3     Island Youth Mentoring, Inc. an application for an exemption from real  
4     property taxes pursuant to section 420-a of the real property tax law  
5     for the 2008-2009 assessment roll, as to which March 1, 2008 was the  
6     taxable status date, with respect to the real property taxes for the  
7     2008-2009 assessment roll for the parcel owned by such organization  
8     located in the town of Islip at 153 McNair Street, Brentwood, otherwise  
9     known as: district 500, section 114, block 3, lot 90.  
10    (b) If accepted, such application shall be reviewed as if it had been  
11    received on or before the taxable status date established for such  
12    rolls.  
13    If satisfied that such organization would otherwise be entitled to  
14    such exemption if the organization had filed an application for  
15    exemption by the appropriate taxable status date, the assessor of the  
16    town of Islip, upon approval by the town board of such town, may grant  
17    exemption from all taxation based on the 2008-2009 assessment roll and  
18    owing by such organization on the effective date of this act and cancel  
19    taxes, fines, penalties and interest remaining unpaid, and make appro-  
20    priate corrections to the subject roll. If such exemption is granted  
21    and such organization shall have paid any tax with respect to the  
22    subject roll, the applicable department of the town of Islip, upon the  
23    approval of the town board of such town, may in its sole discretion  
24    provide for the refund of those taxes paid and cancel taxes, fines,  
25    penalties or interest remaining unpaid.  
26    S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
