- AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to the local disaster preparedness plans of a city having a population of five hundred thousand or more inhabitants

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 23 of the executive law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 1-a to read as follows:

3 EVENT THAT ANY CITY HAVING A POPULATION OF FIVE HUNDRED 1-A. IN THE4 THOUSAND OR MORE INHABITANTS PREPARES A LOCAL DISASTER PREPAREDNESS 5 PLAN, SUCH PLAN SHALL USE THE UP-TO-DATE INDUSTRY STANDARD OR THE BEST б TECHNOLOGY AVAILABLE, INCLUDING COMPUTER MODELS, TO DEVELOP EVACUATION 7 TIME ESTIMATES, WHICH SHALL BE USED TO COMPLETE SUCH PLAN. IN THE EVENT THAT ANY SUCH CITY HAS ALREADY DEVELOPED SUCH A PLAN, SUCH PLAN SHALL BE 8 REVISED TO COME INTO COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBDIVISION, 9 UNLESS THE DISASTER PREPAREDNESS COMMISSION, AS DEFINED IN PARAGRAPH D 10 SUBDIVISION TWO OF SECTION TWENTY OF THIS ARTICLE, DETERMINES THAT 11 OF SUCH PLAN IS ALREADY IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS 12 SUBDIVI-SAID DISASTER PREPAREDNESS COMMISSION SHALL ASSIST ANY SUCH CITY 13 SION. WITH THE DEVELOPMENT THEREOF. 14

15 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 16 it shall have become a law.
