Introduced by Sen. OPPENHEIMER -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Health

AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to the definition of summer day camp and to repeal certain provisions of such law relating thereto

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 1392 of the public health law, as  
2 added by chapter 515 of the laws of 2000, is amended to read as follows:  
3 2. "Summer day camp" shall mean a property consisting of a tract of  
4 land and any tents, vehicles, buildings or other structures that may be  
5 pertinent to its use, any part of which may be occupied on a scheduled  
6 basis at any time between June first and September fifteenth in any year  
7 by children under sixteen years of age under general supervision,  
8 [primarily] for the purpose of INDOOR OR outdoor organized group activ-  
9 ities, INVOLVING TWO OR MORE NONPASSIVE RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES WITH  
10 SIGNIFICANT RISK OF INJURY, AS SUCH ACTIVITIES ARE DEFINED BY THE  
11 DEPARTMENT IN RULES AND REGULATIONS, for a period of less than twenty-  
12 four hours on any day the property is so occupied, and on which no  
13 provisions are made for overnight occupancy by such children. The  
14 commissioner shall have the power to except by rule from this article  
15 and the sanitary code a place, facility or activity that is not within  
16 the intent of this definition.  
17 S 2. Subdivision 4 of section 1393 of the public health law is  
18 REPEALED.  
19 S 3. Subdivision 5 of section 1393 of the public health law is renum-  
20 bered subdivision 4.  
21 S 4. This act shall take effect April 1, 2011.
