AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to providing for a study of integrated pest management of state facilities

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 33-0101 of the environmental conservation law is amended by adding a new subdivision 27-a to read as follows:

- 27-A. "INTEGRATED PEST MANAGEMENT" MEANS A SUSTAINABLE APPROACH MANAGING PESTS THAT RELIES ON:
- EMPLOYMENT OF PHYSICAL, MECHANICAL, CULTURAL, BIOLOGICAL, AND EDUCATIONAL TACTICS TO CONTROL CONDITIONS THAT PROMOTE PEST INFESTA-TIONS, TO KEEP PEST POPULATIONS AT TOLERABLE DAMAGE OR ANNOYANCE LEVELS, AND TO MINIMIZE THE OVERALL USE OF OR RELIANCE ON PESTICIDES;
- B. THE APPLICATION OF AN INTERCONNECTED SET OF PRINCIPLES AND METHODS 9 TO PROBLEMS CAUSED BY INSECTS, VERTEBRATES, WEEDS, AND DISEASES 10 ATTACK PLANTS INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, GENERAL EDUCATION ON INTE-11 GRATED PEST MANAGEMENT FOR WORK SITE EMPLOYEES, TECHNICAL TRAINING 12 13 EMPLOYEES DIRECTLY INVOLVED IN PREMISES MANAGEMENT, AND THE PROPER CLEANING/MAINTENANCE, HANDLING, AND DISPOSAL OF FOOD AND ORGANIC 14 15 PRODUCTS;
- 16 USE, TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT FEASIBLE, OF ALTERNATIVES TO ANY 17 PESTICIDE CLASSIFIED AS A KNOWN, LIKELY, PROBABLE, OR POSSIBLE HUMAN 18 CARCINOGEN BY THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY; AND
- THE ELIMINATION OF THE USE OF ANY PESTICIDE CLASSIFIED AS TOXICITY CATEGORY I OR II BY THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY, 20 EXCEPT WHERE NECESSARY TO ADDRESS AN ACUTE HUMAN HEALTH EMERGENCY.
