AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to permitting an electronic signature to make an anatomical gift

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 4310 of the public health law, amended by chapter 362 of the laws of 2008, is amended to read as 3 follows:
- 2. Such registration of consent to make an anatomical gift can be made 5 through (a) indication made on the application or renewal form of a license, (b) indication made on a non-driver identification card appli-7 cation or renewal form, (c) enrolling in the registry website maintained by the department, (d) indication made on a voter registration form 8 9 pursuant to subdivision five of section 5-210 of the election law, or (e) through any other method identified by the commissioner. NOTWITH-10 STANDING SECTION THREE HUNDRED SEVEN OF THE STATE TECHNOLOGY LAW, A 11 12 REGISTRATION OF CONSENT TO MAKE AN ANATOMICAL GIFT MAY BE MADE USING AN ELECTRONIC SIGNATURE AND SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE OTHER PROVISIONS OF 13 ARTICLE THREE OF THE STATE TECHNOLOGY LAW. The registration shall take 14 effect upon the department sending written notice of the registration to 15
- the person enrolling in the registry. 17 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
