AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to claims against certain entities based upon use of an electronic toll collection system

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 2985 of the public authorities law is designated as
2 title 12 of article 9 and a new title heading is added to read as
3 follows:

4 ELECTRONIC TOLL COLLECTION

5 S 2. Title 12 of article 9 of the public authorities law is amended by
6 adding two new sections 2986 and 2987 to read as follows:

7 S 2986. ELECTRONIC TOLL COLLECTION DISPUTES. ANY DISPUTE RELATING TO
8 CHARGES IMPOSED BY AN ELECTRONIC TOLL COLLECTION SYSTEM MADE BY AN
9 ACCOUNT HOLDER MAY BE BROUGHT IN THE COUNTY COURT IN THE COUNTY IN WHICH
10 SUCH ACCOUNT HOLDER RESIDES, OR IN THE CIVIL COURT OF THE CITY OF NEW
11 YORK IF THE ACCOUNT HOLDER RESIDES WITHIN ITS JURISDICTION OR IN A
12 DISTRICT COURT HAVING JURISDICTION OVER SUCH ACCOUNT HOLDER.

13 S 2987. CONTRACTS FOR USE OF ELECTRONIC TOLL COLLECTION. ANY CONTRACT
14 OR AGREEMENT BETWEEN A CONSUMER AND A PUBLIC AUTHORITY WHICH PROVIDES
15 FOR USE OF A SYSTEM OR DEVICE FACILITATING ELECTRONIC TOLL COLLECTION
16 SHALL CLEARLY STATE THE NAME, ADDRESS AND TELEPHONE NUMBER OF THE LEGAL
17 ENTITY WITH WHICH THE CONSUMER IS CONTRACTING FOR SERVICE. ANY SUCH
18 CONTRACT OR AGREEMENT SHALL ALSO CLEARLY STATE, IN A SEPARATE SECTION,
19 HOW AND WHERE A CONSUMER MAY CHALLENGE ANY CHANGES MADE ON HIS OR HER
20 ACCOUNT. SUCH NOTICE SHALL INCLUDE SPECIFIC CONTACT INFORMATION RELATING
21 TO SETTLING DISPUTES RELATING TO CHARGES AS WELL AS IDENTIFYING THE
22 COURT IN WHICH A CLAIM MAY BE BROUGHT, THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS FOR
23 SUCH CLAIM AND ANY STEPS WHICH A CLAIMANT MAY BE REQUIRED TO TAKE BEFORE
24 MAKING A CLAIM.

25 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
