AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to requiring the metropolitan transportation authority to hold a public hearing prior to the awarding of a sole source contract

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The public authorities law is amended by adding a new 2 section 1265-b to read as follows:
- 3 S 1265-B. SOLE SOURCE CONTRACTS. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY INCONSISTENT 4 PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER, EXCEPT WHEN THERE IS AN EMERGENCY INVOLVING 5 DANGER TO LIFE OR PROPERTY, THE AUTHORITY SHALL NOT AWARD A SOLE SOURCE 6 CONTRACT WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING THEREON UNTIL IT SHALL HAVE HELD A 7 PUBLIC HEARING ON THE AWARD OF SUCH CONTRACT PRIOR TO THE MAKING OF SUCH 8 AWARD. NOTICE OF SUCH HEARING SHALL BE PUBLISHED PRIOR THERETO ONCE A
- 9 WEEK FOR TWO SUCCESSIVE WEEKS IN TWO OF THE DAILY NEWSPAPERS PUBLISHED
- 10 IN THE CITY AND IN THE CITY RECORDS. PUBLIC COMMENT SHALL BE HEARD WITH 11 RESPECT TO SUCH PROPOSED AWARD OF CONTRACT. ANY RESOLUTION OF THE
- 11 RESPECT TO SUCH PROPOSED AWARD OF CONTRACT. ANY RESOLUTION OF THE 12 AUTHORITY AWARDING SUCH A SOLE SOURCE CONTRACT WITHOUT COMPETITIVE
- 13 BIDDING SHALL BE ADOPTED ONLY AFTER SUCH HEARING AND SHALL STATE THE
- 14 REASONS THEREFOR. THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL NOT APPLY TO
- 15 CONTRACTS FOR PERSONAL, ARCHITECTURAL, ENGINEERING, OR OTHER PROFES-
- 16 SIONAL SERVICES.
- 17 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall

18 have become a law.
