AN ACT to authorize the First United Methodist Church of Roosevelt to file an application for real property tax exemptions

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,
2 the assessor of the county of Nassau is hereby authorized to accept from
3 First United Methodist Church of Roosevelt an application for exemption
4 from real property taxes pursuant to section 420-a of the real property
5 tax law for the 2006-2007 and 2007-2008 assessment rolls for the parcel
6 owned by such organization located in the hamlet of Roosevelt in the
7 town of Hempstead at 30 Union Place, Roosevelt, New York, otherwise
8 known as section 55, block 418, lot 101. If accepted, such application
9 shall be reviewed as if it had been received on or before the taxable
10 status date established for such rolls. If satisfied that such organiza-
11 tion would otherwise be entitled to such exemption if such organization
12 had filed an application or renewal application for exemption by the
13 appropriate taxable status date, the assessor, upon approval by the
14 Nassau county legislature, may make appropriate correction to the
15 subject rolls. If such exemption is granted and such organization,
16 therefore, shall have paid any tax with respect to the subject rolls,
17 the applicable governing body or tax department may, in its sole
18 discretion, provide for the refund of those taxes paid and cancel those
19 taxes, fines, penalties, liens, or interest remaining unpaid.
20 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
