AN ACT to amend the real property tax law, in relation to limiting the increase in real property taxes resulting from a reassessment

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The real property tax law is amended by adding a new 2 section 306 to read as follows:
 - S 306. REASSESSMENT TAX INCREASES; LIMITS. ANY INCREASE IN THE REAL PROPERTY TAX LIABILITY OF ANY PARCEL OF REAL PROPERTY RESULTING FROM A REVALUATION, REASSESSMENT OR UPDATE, AS DEFINED PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION TWELVE-A OF SECTION ONE HUNDRED TWO OF THIS CHAPTER, SHALL BE LIMITED TO FIVE PERCENT OF THE REAL PROPERTY TAX LIABILITY OF SUCH PARCEL ESTABLISHED BY THE ASSESSMENT ROLL PREPARED ON THE BASIS OF THE TAXABLE STATUS DATE OCCURRING IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO SUCH REVALUATION, REASSESSMENT OR UPDATE. NO PROVISION OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO LIMIT OR PROHIBIT ANY MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, AS DEFINED PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION TEN OF SECTION ONE HUNDRED TWO OF THIS CHAPTER, FROM INCREASING THE
- 13 RATE OF REAL PROPERTY TAXES ASSESSED ON REAL PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN ITS
- 14 JURISDICTION AS IS OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED AND PROVIDED BY LAW.
- 15 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
