AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to workers on excavations

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The labor law is amended by adding a new section 28 to read 2 as follows:
- S 28. WORKERS ON EXCAVATIONS. UTILITY COMPANIES OR THEIR CONTRACTORS,
- TO WHOM A PERMIT MAY BE ISSUED BY THE STATE, A COUNTY OR A MUNICIPALITY 5 TO USE OR OPEN A STREET, SHALL BE REQUIRED, BEFORE SUCH PERMIT SHALL BE
- 6 ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT THAT ONLY COMPETENT WORKERS SKILLED
- 7 IN THE WORK REQUIRED OF THEM, SHALL BE EMPLOYED ON THE PROJECT FOR WHICH
- 8 SUCH PERMIT TO USE OR OPEN A STREET WAS ISSUED, AND THAT THE PREVAILING
- WAGE FOR SIMILAR TITLES AS ESTABLISHED BY THE FISCAL OFFICER PURSUANT TO 9
- 10 SECTION TWO HUNDRED TWENTY OF THIS CHAPTER, BEPAID TO THOSE SO EMPLOYED. NO PERMIT SHALL BE ISSUED UNTIL SUCH AGREEMENT SHALL HAVE BEEN 11
- 12 ENTERED INTO WITH THE APPROPRIATE STATE, COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL AGENCY, AND
- 13 ALL PERMITS ISSUED AFTER $_{
 m THE}$ EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION SHALL
- INCLUDE THEREIN A COPY OF THIS SECTION. WHEN PERMITS ARE ISSUED TO UTIL-14
- 15 ITY COMPANIES OR THEIR CONTRACTORS, THE POWER TO ENFORCE THE TERMS OF
- THIS SECTION SHALL BE VESTED WITH THE DEPARTMENT CONSISTENT 16 17 PROVISIONS OF SECTION TWO HUNDRED TWENTY OF THIS CHAPTER.
- S 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 18
