AN ACT to amend the village law, in relation to permitting village justices of the village of Sag Harbor to live in the towns of East Hampton or Southampton

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 3-300 of the village law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 19 to read as follows:
  - 19. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER OR ANY OTHER GENERAL LAW, LOCAL LAW, ORDINANCE, OR SPECIAL ACT, THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF SAG HARBOR, SUFFOLK COUNTY, MAY, BY RESOLUTION, PROVIDE THAT THE OFFICE OF VILLAGE JUSTICE OF SUCH VILLAGE MAY BE HELD BY A PERSON WHO IS NOT A RESIDENT OF SUCH VILLAGE, PROVIDED THAT SUCH PERSON RESIDES WITHIN EITHER THE TOWN OF EAST HAMPTON OR THE TOWN OF SOUTHAMPTON WITHIN SUFFOLK COUNTY.
- 10 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
