AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to vacancies in the office of United States senator

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 4-a of section 42 of the public officers law, as amended by chapter 373 of the laws of 1978, is amended to read as follows:

4-a. If a vacancy occurs in the office of United States senator from this state [in any even numbered calendar year on or after the fiftyninth day prior to the annual primary election, or thereafter during 7 said even numbered year, the governor shall make a temporary appointment to fill such vacancy until the third day of January in the year follow-9 ing the next even numbered calendar year. If such vacancy occurs in any even numbered calendar year on or before the sixtieth day prior to an 10 annual primary election, the governor shall make a temporary appointment 11 to fill such vacancy until the third day of January in the next calendar 12 13 year. If a vacancy occurs in the office of United States senator from this state in any odd numbered calendar year, the governor shall make a 14 temporary appointment to fill such vacancy until the third day of Janu-15 16 in the next odd numbered calendar year. Such an appointment shall 17 be evidenced by a certificate of the governor which shall be filed in the office of the state board of elections. At the time for filing such 18 19 certificate], the GOVERNOR MAY IN HIS OR HER DISCRETION, MAKE PROCLAMA-TION OF A SPECIAL ELECTION TO FILL SUCH OFFICE, SPECIFYING THE DATE OF 20 SUCH ELECTION, WHICH SHALL NOT BE LESS THAN FORTY-FIVE 21 NOR MORE 22 SIXTY DAYS FROM THE DATE OF SUCH PROCLAMATION. THE governor shall issue 23 and file in the office of the state board of elections a writ of 24 election directing the election of a United States senator to fill such vacancy for the unexpired term at the general election next preceding 25 the expiration for the term of such [appointment] SPECIAL ELECTION. 26

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
