AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to contents to be contained in a certificate of death

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 4141 of the public health amended by adding a new paragraph (e) to read as follows:

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- WHERE A DEATH IS CAUSED BY INJURIES RELATED TO THE TERRORIST ATTACKS ON SEPTEMBER ELEVENTH, TWO THOUSAND ONE, SUCH INFORMATION SHALL INDICATED, INCLUDING ANY RELATED INFORMATION AS THE COMMISSIONER MAY REOUIRE.
- S 2. Subdivision 3 of section 4143 of the public health law, amended by chapter 545 of the laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:
- 3. The coroner or medical examiner whose duty it is to investigate the death and to execute the certificate of death, shall state in such 11 certificate the name of the disease causing death, or if from external causes, the means of death; whether probably accidental, 14 homicidal; OR WHERE A DEATH IS CAUSED BY INJURIES RELATING TO THE TERRORIST ATTACKS ON SEPTEMBER ELEVENTH, TWO THOUSAND ONE, SUCH INFORMA-TION SHALL BE INDICATED, and shall, in any case, furnish such 17 tion as may be required by the commissioner in order to classify the 18 death.
- 19 S 3. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it 20 have become a law.
