Introduced by Sen. FOLEY -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Education

AN ACT to amend the education law and the general municipal law, relation to requiring that any plumbing or electrical work on a school building be performed by a licensed master plumber or licensed electrician

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 408-c to read as follows:
  - S 408-C. PLUMBING AND ELECTRICAL WORK. ALL PLUMBING AND ELECTRICAL WORK PERFORMED ON ANY SCHOOL BUILDING OR APPURTENANT FACILITIES SHALL BE COMPLETED BY A LICENSED MASTER PLUMBER OR LICENSED ELECTRICIAN, IF FACILITY REQUIRED BY A LOCAL MUNICIPALITY WHERE THEBUILDING OR SUCH MASTER PLUMBER OR ELECTRICIAN SHALL PROVIDE A COPY OF HIS OR HER VALID LICENSE WHEN SUBMITTING HIS OR HER BID RESPONSE LICENSE OR IF IT IS UNDER THE THRESHOLD REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SECTION ONE HUNDRED ONE OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW, THE GENERAL CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT A COPY OF THE LICENSE FOR THE PLUMBING AND ELECTRICAL SUBCONTRAC-TORS. NO MUNICIPAL PERMIT OR INSPECTION IS REQUIRED.
- 13 S 2. Section 101 of the general municipal law is amended by adding a 14 new subdivision 6 to read as follows:
- ALL PLUMBING AND ELECTRICAL WORK PERFORMED ON ANY SCHOOL BUILDING 15 OR APPURTENANT FACILITIES SHALL BE COMPLETED BY A LICENSED MASTER 16 17 BER OR LICENSED ELECTRICIAN, IF REQUIRED BY A LOCAL MUNICIPALITY WHERE THE BUILDING OR FACILITY IS LOCATED. SUCH MASTER PLUMBER OR ELECTRICIAN 18 SHALL PROVIDE A COPY OF HIS OR HER VALID LICENSE WHEN SUBMITTING HIS OR 19 20 HER BID RESPONSE IF A LICENSE OR IF IT IS UNDER THE THRESHOLD TO THIS SECTION, THE GENERAL CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT A COPY OF PURSUANT
- 21 THE LICENSE FOR THE PLUMBING AND ELECTRICAL SUBCONTRACTORS. NO MUNICIPAL 22
- 23 PERMIT OR INSPECTION IS REQUIRED.
