AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to itinerant vendors

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     Section 1. Section 38 of the general business law, as added by chapter  
2     282 of the laws of 1995, is amended to read as follows:
- 3     S 38. Prohibited sales. No itinerant vendor, except for A MANUFACTUR-  
4     ER, an authorized manufacturer's representative, or authorized distribu-  
5     tor, shall offer for sale any of the following items:
- 6     1. [Food manufactured and packaged for sale for consumption by a child  
7     under the age of two years; or
- 8     2. Drugs as defined in section three thousand three hundred two of the  
9     public health law] BABY FOOD, WHICH SHALL INCLUDE ANY FOOD MANUFACTURED  
10    AND PACKAGED SPECIFICALLY FOR CONSUMPTION BY A CHILD UNDER TWO YEARS OF  
11    AGE. THE TERM SHALL INCLUDE INFANT FORMULA;
- 12    2. NONPRESCRIPTION DRUGS, WHICH SHALL INCLUDE ANY NON-NARCOTIC MEDI-  
13    CINE OR DRUG THAT MAY BE SOLD WITHOUT A PRESCRIPTION. THE TERM SHALL  
14    INCLUDE ANY DRUGS COMMONLY KNOWN AS "OVER-THE-COUNTER DRUGS," HERBAL  
15    PRODUCTS, DIETARY SUPPLEMENTS, BOTANICAL EXTRACTS, AND VITAMINS AND  
16    SUBSTANCES RECOGNIZED AS DRUGS IN THE OFFICIAL UNITED STATES PHARMACOPO-  
17    EIA, OFFICIAL HOMEOPATHIC PHARMACOPOEIA OF THE UNITED STATES, OR OFFI-  
18    CIAL NATIONAL FORMULARY, OR ANY SUPPLEMENT TO SUCH PUBLICATIONS;
- 19    3. COSMETICS, WHICH SHALL MEAN MERCHANDISE, OTHER THAN SOAP, BUT  
20    INCLUDING RAZOR BLADES, THAT IS INTENDED TO BE RUBBED, POURED, SPRIN-  
21    KLED, OR SPRAYED ONTO, INTRODUCED INTO, OR OTHERWISE APPLIED TO THE  
22    HUMAN BODY OR ANY PART THEREOF FOR CLEANSING, BEAUTIFYING, PROMOTING  
23    ATTRACTIVENESS, OR ALTERING THE APPEARANCE OF THE HUMAN BODY OR ANY PART  
24    THEREOF.
- 25    S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
