AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to administrative hearings and processes for pet dealers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 404 of the agriculture and 2 markets law, as added by chapter 259 of the laws of 2000, is amended to 3 read as follows:
- Before any license shall be suspended or revoked, the commission-5 er, or any hearing officer he or she may designate, shall hold a hearing, upon due notice to the licensee, in accordance with any regulations 6 7 promulgated by the department and in accordance with articles three and four of the state administrative procedure act. SUCH A HEARING 9 MANDATED TO BE HELD IF A LICENSEE FAILS EITHER THREE CONSECUTIVE 10 INSPECTIONS PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION OR THREE INSPECTIONS IN 11 YEAR PERIOD PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION. NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL PROHIBIT THE COMMISSIONER FROM TAKING ADDITIONAL ACTIONS REGARDING 12 BY A LICENSEE OF EITHER THREE CONSECUTIVE 13 LICENSES PRIOR TO FAILURE 14 INSPECTIONS OR THREE INSPECTIONS IN A THREE YEAR PERIOD.
- 15 S 2. This act shall take effect April 1, 2011; provided, however, 16 that effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any 17 rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its 18 effective date are authorized and directed to be made and completed on 19 or before such effective date.
