THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Legislative intent. The legislature hereby finds 1 Section 1. and 2 declares that the enactment of these appropriations provides sufficient 3 authority to the comptroller for the purpose of making payments for the purposes described herein until such time as appropriation bills submit-4 ted by the governor pursuant to article VII of the state constitution 5 for the support of government for the state fiscal year beginning April б 7 1, 2010 are enacted.
