AN ACT to amend the real property tax law, in relation to the base proportion in approved assessing units in Nassau county

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 3 of section 1903 of the 2 property tax law is amended by adding a new subparagraph (xii) to read 3 as follows:

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(XII) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, IN AN ASSESSING UNIT IN THE COUNTY OF NASSAU AND FOR CURRENT BASE PROPORTIONS TO BE DETERMINED BY TAXES BASED ON SUCH APPROVED ASSESSING UNIT'S TWO 7 ASSESSMENT ROLL, THE CURRENT BASE PROPORTION OF ANY CLASS THOUSAND TEN SHALL NOT EXCEED THE ADJUSTED BASE PROPORTION OR ADJUSTED PROPORTION, APPROPRIATE, OF THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING YEAR, BY MORE 9 WHICHEVER IS 10 THAN ONE PERCENT, PROVIDED THAT SUCH APPROVED ASSESSING UNIT HAS 11 LOCAL LAW, ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION PROVIDING THEREFOR. WHERE THE COMPUTATION OF CURRENT BASE PROPORTIONS WOULD OTHERWISE PRODUCE 12 RESULT, THE CURRENT BASE PROPORTION OF SUCH CLASS OR CLASSES SHALL BE 13 14 LIMITED TO SUCH ONE PERCENT INCREASE AND THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF SUCH APPROVED ASSESSING UNIT SHALL ALTER THE CURRENT BASE PROPORTION OF 15 EITHER CLASS SO THAT THE SUM OF THE CURRENT BASE PROPORTION OF 16 EITHER 17 CLASS EQUALS ONE.

This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to the 18 2. 19 levy of taxes based on the 2010 assessment roll in approved assessing 20 units in the county of Nassau that pass a local law, ordinance or resol-21 ution to adopt these provisions.
