AN ACT to authorize the county of Nassau to convey to the Carle Place Water District, certain parklands

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The county of Nassau, acting by and through its county
2 legislature, is hereby authorized to convey by appropriate instruments
3 to the Carle Place Water District, parklands located in the Carle Place
4 Water District and described in section three of this act.

5 S 2. The authorization provided in section one of this act shall be
6 effective only upon the condition that the county of Nassau dedicate an
7 amount equal to or greater than the fair market value of the parklands
8 being alienated pursuant to section one of this act to the acquisition
9 of new parklands and/or capital improvements to existing park and recre-
10 ational facilities.

11 S 3. The parklands to be conveyed by the county of Nassau pursuant to
12 section one of this act is described as follows:

13 All that certain plot, piece or parcel of land, situate, lying and
14 being at Carle Place, Town of North Hempstead, County of Nassau and
15 State of New York, said parcel being more particularly described as
16 follows:

17 BEGINNING at a point on the westerly line of Carle Road, said point
18 being distant 320.08 feet northerly as measured along said westerly line
19 of Carle Road from its intersection with the northerly line of Winnie
20 Court;

21 RUNNING THENCE South 78 degrees 35 minutes 15 seconds West 60.00 feet;

22 RUNNING THENCE North 11 degrees 24 minutes 45 seconds West 27.12 feet;

23 RUNNING THENCE North 78 degrees 35 minutes 15 sections East 60.00 feet

24 to the westerly line of Carle Road;

25 RUNNING THENCE along said westerly line South 11 degrees 24 minutes 45
26 seconds East 27.12 feet to the point or place of beginning.

27 Containing within said bounds 1,627.2 square feet more or less.

1 S 4. The conveyance of the parklands authorized by the provisions of
2 this act shall not occur until the county of Nassau has complied with
3 any federal requirements pertaining to the alienation or conversion of
4 parklands, including satisfying the secretary of the interior that the
5 alienation or conversion complies with all conditions which the secre-
6 tary of the interior deems necessary to assure that the substitution of
7 other lands be equivalent in fair market value and recreational useful-
8 ness to the lands being alienated or converted.

9 S 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
