AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the use of
coercion to expose immigration status as a misdemeanor offense

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 9 of section 135.60 of the penal law, as
2 amended by chapter 426 of the laws of 2008, is amended and a new subdi-
3 vision 10 is added to read as follows:
4 9. Perform any other act which would not in itself materially benefit
5 the actor but which is calculated to harm another person materially with
6 respect to his or her health, safety, business, calling, career, finan-
7 cial condition, reputation or personal relationships[.]; OR
8 10. REVEAL OR DISCLOSE SUCH PERSON'S IMMIGRATION STATUS TO A FEDERAL,
9 STATE OR LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OR FEDERAL IMMIGRATION AUTHORITY.
10 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next
11 succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law.
