AN ACT in relation to transportation maintenance contracts of the North Collins Central School District

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. All acts done and proceedings heretofore had and taken or
2 caused to be had and taken by the North Collins central school district
3 by all officers, employees or agents of such school district relating to
4 or in connection with a transportation maintenance contract with John
5 Gallin's Repair Service, 10014 State Road, North Collins, New York 14111
6 for the 2006-2007 and 2007-2008 school years, and all acts incidental
7 thereto are hereby legalized, validated, ratified and confirmed,
8 notwithstanding any failure to comply with the contract award, approval
9 and filing requirements of the education law, or any other law or any
10 statutory authority, rule or regulation, other than those filing
11 provisions defined in paragraph a of subdivision 5 of section 3604 of
12 the education law, in relation to any omission, error, defect, irreg-
13 ularity, or illegality in such proceedings had and taken.

14 S 2. The department of education is hereby directed to consider the
15 aforementioned contracts for transportation aid as valid and proper
16 obligations of the North Collins central school district.

17 S 3. Any amount due and payable to the North Collins central school
18 district as a result of this act shall be paid pursuant to the
19 provisions of paragraph c of subdivision 5 of section 3604 of the educa-
20 tion law.

21 S 4. This act shall take effect immediately and shall be deemed to
22 have been in full force and effect after June 30, 2006.
