AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to providing enhanced penalties for licensees who sell certain alcoholic beverages to persons under the age of twenty-one years

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 65 of the alcoholic beverage control law is amended 2 by adding a new subdivision 7 to read as follows:

3 7. ANY LICENSEE, OR ITS AGENT OR EMPLOYEE, WHO SELLS, DELIVERS OR GIVES AWAY, OR CAUSES, PERMITS OR PROCURES TO BE SOLD, DELIVERED OR 4 5 GIVEN AWAY TO ANY PERSON, ACTUALLY OR APPARENTLY, UNDER THE AGE OF TWEN-TY-ONE YEARS, ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE THAT CONTAINS MORE THAN TWO PER 6 7 CENTUM OF ALCOHOL BY VOLUME, IN COMBINATION WITH MORE THAN FIVE MILLI-GRAMS PER OUNCE OF CAFFEINE OR ANY OTHER STIMULANT INCLUDING, BUT NOT 8 9 LIMITED TO, GUARANA, GINSENG OR TAURINE THAT HAS AN EQUIVALENT EFFECT AS 10 SUCH OUANTITY OF CAFFEINE, SHALL BE GUILTY OF A CLASS E FELONY AS 11 DEFINED IN THE PENAL LAW.

12 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 13 have become a law.
