AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to prohibiting restaurants from selling foods containing trans fats and requiring the posting of calorie, fat and sodium content in food items sold

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 396-jj to read as follows:

- S 396-JJ. RESTAURANTS; TRANS FATS PROHIBITED. 1. ANY RESTAURANT OR OTHER FOOD SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT WHERE FOOD IS PREPARED OR COOKED AND OFFERED FOR SALE TO THE PUBLIC FOR CONSUMPTION ON PREMISES SHALL NOT UTILIZE ANY TRANS FATS IN THE PREPARATION OR COOKING OF ANY FOOD ITEM OFFERED FOR SALE IN SUCH ESTABLISHMENT AND SHALL NOT OFFER FOR SALE OR SERVE ANY FOOD CONTAINING ANY TRANS FATS.
- 2. WHENEVER THERE SHALL BE A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION, AN APPLICATION MAY BE MADE BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL IN THE NAME OF THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK TO A COURT OR JUSTICE HAVING JURISDICTION BY A SPECIAL PROCEEDING TO ISSUE AN INJUNCTION, AND UPON NOTICE TO THE RESPONDENT OF NOT LESS THAN FIVE DAYS, TO ENJOIN AND RESTRAIN THE CONTINUANCE OF SUCH VIOLATIONS; AND IF IT SHALL APPEAR TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE COURT OR JUSTICE THAT THE RESPONDENT HAS, IN FACT, VIOLATED THIS SECTION, ISSUED BY SUCH COURT OR JUSTICE, ENJOINING AND INJUNCTION MAY BE RESTRAINING ANY FURTHER VIOLATION, WITHOUT REQUIRING PROOF THAT ANY PERSON HAS, IN FACT, BEEN INJURED OR DAMAGED THEREBY. WHENEVER THE COURT SHALL DETERMINE THAT A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION HAS OCCURRED, THE COURT IMPOSE A CIVIL PENALTY OF FIFTY DOLLARS FOR EACH DAY THAT SUCH VIOLATION OCCURS, BUT IN NO EVENT SHALL THE TOTAL PENALTY EXCEED FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS.
