AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to prohibited
practices of creditors

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 601 of the general business law is amended by
2 adding a new subdivision 6-a to read as follows:
3 6-A. COMMUNICATE WITH THE DEBTOR OR ANY MEMBER OF HIS OR HER FAMILY OR
4 HOUSEHOLD AT ANY MEDICAL CARE FACILITY OR ANY FACILITY LICENSED UNDER
5 ARTICLE TWENTY-EIGHT OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH LAW; OR REPRESENT THEMSELVES
6 AS EMPLOYEES OF SUCH FACILITY IN ORDER TO COMMUNICATE A DEBT TO SUCH
7 DEBTOR; OR PREVENT OR DISCOURAGE SUCH DEBTOR FROM RECEIVING MEDICAL CARE
8 OR TREATMENT BY THE PRESENCE OF SUCH CREDITOR AT A FACILITY LICENSED
9 UNDER ARTICLE TWENTY-EIGHT OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH LAW.
10 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
